

- Quality programme for Student and Academic Services: constant improvements of study conditions and the quality of teaching
- Establishment of offers to allow students to have a successful course of studies and support teachers in their professional development
- Funded by the Federal and State Government Programme for better study conditions and better quality in teaching (Higher Education Pact)
- Two funding phases: 10/2011 – 09/2016: 17 Mio. Euro
 10/2016 – 12/2020: 15 Mio. Euro

Field of action I: Introductory Phase

- Manifold consulting and support services to adapt to the growing heterogeneity of potential students
- Aim: facilitate the start into higher education and thus reduce the dropout rate during the first semesters
- ✓ Student Ambassadors
- ✓ Virtual Study Orientation
- ✓ Propaedeutic Studies in Mathematics, Computer Sciences and Physics
- ✓ Information on barrier-free studying
- ✓ Better study and examination advisory services



Field of action II: Professorships

- Aims: Improvement of student-staff ratio and offering of additional courses in highly demanded degree programmes, increase of attractiveness of studying in Göttingen

- ✓ Further development of quality closed loops
- ✓ Establishment of degree programme-monitoring for the University and the University Medical Centre
- ✓ Data management and analysis



Field of action IV: Qualification Programmes


- Constant quality development of teaching through offers furthering qualifications of teaching, coaching and supervising staff
- Close cooperation with the Technical University Clausthal
- ✓ Offers for new appointees, junior academics and teachers at the University and the University Medical
- ✓ Specific offers for different courses and ranges of studies
- ✓ Development of gender-neutral coaching and teaching approaches
- ✓ Qualification programme for personnel in the offices of deans




Field of action V: Freedom for Innovations
