




GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ENROLMENT IN THE 1st YEAR OF UNDERGRADUATE STUDY:

- › Successfully completed appropriate secondary education.
- › Completed procedure for the recognition of secondary-school certificates obtained abroad.
- › Some study programmes require the candidates to pass a test of ability, capacity, and skills.
- › Certificate of Slovene language competency if required by the faculty (faculties determine the required level of Slovene language proficiency and time frame by which students shall pass the Slovene language exam).



GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR ENROLMENT IN THE 1st YEAR OF POSTGRADUATE STUDY:

Master's study programmes (2nd-cycle):

- › completed bachelor's (1st-cycle) programme in the relevant subject area;
- › completed professional or academic programme approved prior to 11 June 2004;
- › equivalent study programme completed abroad.

Doctoral study programmes (3rd-cycle):

- › completed master's (2nd-cycle) programme corresponding to 300 ECTS;
- › completed academic programme approved prior to 11 June 2004;
- › completed professional programme approved prior to 11 June 2004 and specialisation programme;
- › completed academic programme approved prior to 11 June 2004 and specialisation programme;
- › completed Master of Science programme approved prior to 11 June 2004;
- › equivalent study programme completed abroad.

RECOGNITION OF FOREIGN EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FURTHER EDUCATION AT THE UNIVERSITY OF MARIBOR

In Slovenia, under the Assessment and Recognition of Education Act (ZVPI), candidates who have finished their studies in a foreign country (not Slovenia) and would like to continue education at the University of Maribor are obliged to acquire a decision on the recognition of foreign education (if they have not obtained one already).

In this case, the application form for enrolment is also an application for the initiation of the process of recognition of foreign education for the purpose of further education at the University of Maribor (if the candidate states in the application form that he/she has finished previous education outside of Slovenia and not yet obtained a decision on recognition of foreign education). The form is submitted via the eVS web portal ([http://](http://portal.evs.gov.si/prijava/?locale=en)

portal.evs.gov.si/prijava/?locale=en) within specified time periods when the call for applications is open.

The decision on recognition of foreign education for the purpose of further education at the University of Maribor is a mandatory document for the candidate's enrolment application to be complete.

Candidates are recommended to begin the process of recognition in a timely manner. The deadline for issuing a decision on the recognition under the Assessment and Recognition of Education Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 87/2011, Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 97/2011 - corr. and Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 109/2012) is two months from the receipt of a complete application.

HOW MUCH DO I HAVE TO PAY FOR STUDYING?

The amount of the tuition fee is set by the relevant educational institution and is equal to the tuition fee of part-time study programmes for Slovene citizens. The tuition for the current academic year must be paid upon enrolment. The price list is available at: www.um.si/studij/financiranje/Strani/default.aspx.

Foreign citizens who reside in the Republic of Slovenia and are taxable persons there (or their parents/guardians), EU citizens, and citizens of countries Slovenia has concluded bilateral agreements with are exempted from paying the tuition fee for full-time undergraduate and postgraduate master's study programmes (2nd-cycle).


