In support of young scientists and scholars, the Presidential Board of the Georg-August-Universität Göttingen announces that scholarships for young female academics are available in the context of the research-oriented standards on gender equality set out by the Deutsche Forschungsgemeinschaft (German Research Foundation). In the fourth call for applications for the winter semester 2012/13 nine scholarships will be awarded. Those eligible to apply are excellent young female scientists and scholars aiming for a senior position in academia/research who intend to conduct a research project in cooperation with scientists/scholars at the Georg-August-Universität (including the University Medical School, Göttingen).
